Get Involved "But [Jesus] needed to go through Samaria." (John 4:4, NKJV)

Norena's South Florida home was severely damaged during Hurricane Andrew in 1992. She received an insurance settlement, and the repair work began. But the contractors left when the money ran out, leaving an unfinished home with no electricity. For 15 years, Norena got by with a tiny refrigerator and a few lamps connected to extension cords. Surprisingly, her neighbors didn't seem to notice her dilemma. Then, acting on a tip, the mayor got involved and contacted an electrical contractor who restored power to her house within a few hours.

When Jesus encountered the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4), He got involved in her life and talked to her about her need for spiritual power. He established common ground with her (water, v. 7) and piqued her spiritual interest and curiosity (vv. 9-14). He was gracious and sensitive as he confronted her sin (vv. 16-19) and kept the conversation centered on the main issue (vv. 21-24). Then He confronted her directly with who He was as the Messiah (v. 26). As a result, she and many other Samaritans believed in Him (vv. 39-42).

Let's get involved in the lives of others and share the love of Jesus with them. He is the only source of spiritual power and satisfies our deepest longings.

One with Christ: Activate in Me the Involvement of Christ (Acts 2:42-47, Mark 10:45, Galatians 5:13-14)

This week, we continue our series on being activated to be one with Christ, exploring the process of becoming more like Jesus and living out this formation.

When we receive Jesus into our lives, we set out on a journey to become more like Him. We need to understand more about what He is like, become more like His character, and express it through action.

We look at this journey of becoming more like Christ Jesus through the lens of our theme for this year: Lighthouse United, LIFE in Christ. Today, we are on the second letter of this LIFE acronym: **Involvement**.

One expression of what Jesus is like— and therefore what we should be like — is that Jesus was involved. God has called us to be involved in the lives of the people we interact with, in the family of believers here in the church and outside of it. And this involvement we are to emulate is very personal. Yes, Jesus spoke to crowds of people and performed miracles in front of thousands. But Jesus is also an intimate God, who shared meals in people's homes, spoke to individuals oneon-one, and healed the sicknesses of individuals. Jesus is the God who knows us personally and wants a relationship with us.

So, we, too, are called to this personal type of involvement in people's lives. Less of a "how are you?" as a greeting and more of a "how are you?" as an invitation to dig past the surface level and get to know people and their situations. When we understand what's going on, we can take action. God has called us to be involved in the lives of His creation, so in love and obedience, let us step out in faith and act upon this command.
