God's Presence to Lead, Direct, and Walk Alongside Psalm 23:3b-4

The Lord, our Good Shepherd, is with us to lead us through difficult times. And besides us to make the right decisions, make the right choices. Today, Thomas Lau & Jun Unlayao, will share.

"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." - Psalm 23:4

This verse is one of the most well-known in the Bible. You've likely seen it on calendars, posters, or even quoted in movies.

Perhaps its widespread recognition stems from the fact that during the darkest moments of our lives-whether it's the loss of a loved one, a prolonged illness, career struggles, or business setbacks-we are often forced to face how little control we have over things we once took for granted: our job, our health, our finances, and even our lives. In the blink of an eye, all of it can be taken away. And it's in those moments that we often find ourselves turning back to God.

David reminds us that, even in these challenging times, there is always hope. We have a personal relationship with the Creator of the universe. It's not simply "He is with me" from a distant place, but "YOU" are with me-underscoring an intimate, oneon-one connection. The rod, used by the shepherd to protect the sheep, symbolizes God's protection over us, while the staff, used to guide us, leads us down the right path—even when it seems all hope has vanished.

Today, I want to share my testimony of the time I lost my daughter. Through this experience, I learned that God's answers are not always what we expect, but they are always for a greater purpose. He did not abandon me in my grief; instead, He carried me through it. I realized that my prayers for healing were answered in a different way-she is now healed, free from pain, and in the presence of the Lord.

I share this testimony not to dwell on the loss but to testify to God's faithfulness, even in the darkest times. I am learning to praise Him not only for the answered prayers but also for the strength He gives us to endure unanswered ones.

If you are facing a trial or waiting on God for something, I encourage you to trust His plan. His ways are higher than ours, and His love for us never fails.
